## Ms. Chan Chia Wei Registered Clinical Psychologist

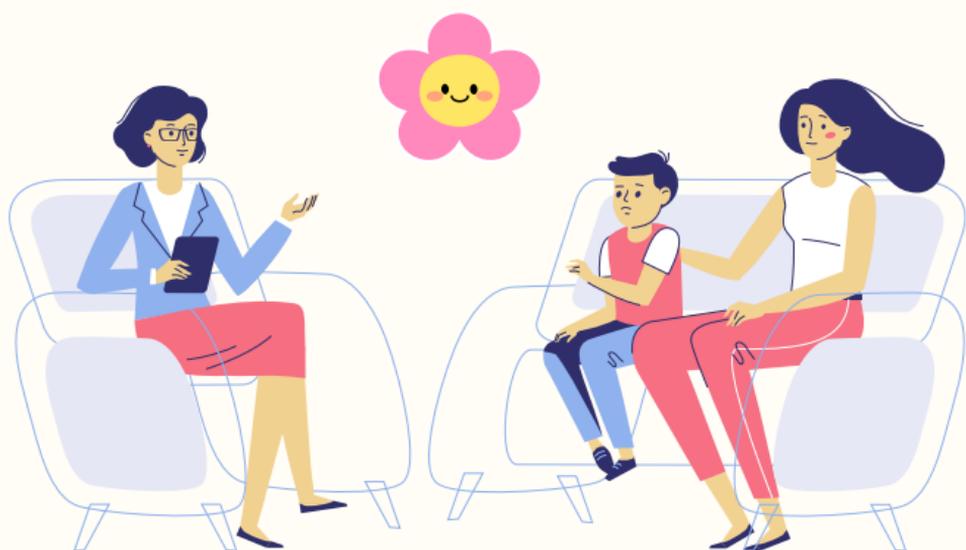

**Assessment and Diagnosis –**  
Evaluating children for neurodevelopmental disorders; Autism Spectrum Disorder, Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, Specific Learning Disorder, Communication Disorders



**Therapy –**  
Providing individual to address issues like emotional regulation, behavioral problems, and trauma.



**Behavioral Interventions –**  
Implementing strategies to manage challenging behaviors, improve social skills, and enhance coping mechanisms.



**Support for Developmental Issues –**  
Helping children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD), developmental delays, or other special needs.



**Parental Guidance –**

**Crisis Intervention –**  
Providing immediate help during stressful or traumatic situations to support the child's recovery.
